



VOLUNTEER SERVING DESCRIPTIONS

Sunday Serving

Welcome Team: Welcoming individuals and families to Emmanuel Church on Sunday afternoons. Volunteers will need to arrive to church by 3:25 for a pre-service planning meeting and prayer with the serving teams. The team is in place and ready to provide a warm, friendly welcome by 3:40pm.

Tech Team: The tech team is responsible for ensuring the timing and quality of the audio and visual slides for the Sunday service. This is a team of 2-3 individuals that would need to arrive on Sundays by 2pm for tech setup, worship band rehearsal and mic and video testing.

Refreshments Team: Serving coffee, giving a smile, and having great conversation are all part of this role! The refreshments team will setup and serve coffee and delicious treats on Sundays. This team of two arrives at 3pm to setup and are ready to serve attendees after the worship service.

Set Up/Tear Down Team: Putting out chairs, laying out bulletins, setting up signage, and more! This team ensures that we are ready to welcome and worship every Sunday. The set up/tear down team arrives by 3pm for setup and stays after service for tear down.

Worship Band: If you have a musical gift, we'd love for you to join the band! The worship band arrives on Sundays at 2:30pm for rehearsals. This team does require auditions prior to serving. If you have a musical gift, we'd love to hear from you!

Children's & Youth Ministry: This team is for individuals who are passionate about investing in our youngest little ones. Emmanuel offers programming for babies to elementary and we are looking for volunteers to serve in these environments. Volunteers would arrive by 3:15 to help setup. Children's ministry teachers are in the classroom environments by 3:40 and ready to welcome children to learn about Jesus! This ministry does require a background check to ensure a safe environment for our children.

Special Needs Ministry: Emmanuel Church is passionate about special needs ministry. We want to be a church for all abilities where everyone can experience worship service and every child can participate in children's ministry. Special needs ministry serving roles include the special needs champion and one-to-one buddies. This ministry requires a background check.

*We believe that everyone is called to serve practically, and we welcome children and youth to serve on Sunday teams. Because of team responsibilities and safety concerns, some teams are more restrictive than others. We'd love to discuss this further if you would like your child to serve at Emmanuel!
